

Private Liability Insurance for American Fulbright grantees in Germany

VICTORIA Versicherung provides health insurance coverage to many American grantees. As a result of this cooperation VICTORIA Versicherung is also able to offer Fulbright grantees a special private liability insurance (Privat-Haftpflichtversicherung) for the duration of their grant period in Germany (including short periods before grant inception and/or short periods after termination of grant with a maximum of 16 months altogether). This special insurance will protect Fulbrighters and accompanying legal dependents (spouse, children) from claims against them as a result of bodily injury, property damage, or causing pure financial losses from other persons who are not related to them. It will not cover any damage or injury as a result of driving a car.

VICTORIA liability insurance will protect the policy holder world-wide but not in the United States.

Please note that you have to agree to a debit procedure (Lastschriftverfahren) where by you allow VICTORIA Versicherung to collect the due premium from your bank account. In other words, you can only apply if you already have (or will have within two weeks of application) a German bank account as listed on the application form.

VICTORIA in turn will provide you with a liability insurance certificate which will also include the terms and conditions of the insurance in German.

The premium is Euro 55 per family.

We congratulate you on your Fulbright award to Germany and hope that our special liability insurance offer will make your Fulbright grant period even more trouble free.
