

2) SPECIAL SECTION FOR PROFESSORS WITH TEACHING ASSIGNMENTS

End of summer semester

The summer term usually ends by July 15th, if covered by your grant. Some universities, though, will hold courses for up to two weeks after this date. If you decide to remain at your host institution until the end of the "Vorlesungszeit", the Commission may extend your full-grant to cover the actual period. This extension is limited to those scholars with teaching schedules and in the full-maintenance category. Please inform us if you need an extension by April 30, 2010, at the latest.

a) If you wish to stay in Germany after your grant expires, please feel free to do so at your own expense and keep us posted of your address. Please be aware that you have to leave the country once your visa expires, or you have to take care of an extension yourself. There is no "tourist" status if you stay on.

b) Professors with grants for the winter semester only should submit their Westbound Transportation forms **soon** and both parts of the final report before they leave the country. Report Part II is on our homepage also (www.fulbright.de click on "To Germany" then "2009-2010 Grantees" then "Circular IV")

Fulbright professors whose grants are finished by the time of the Berlin Seminar but who are still in Germany are welcome to take part as our guests.

Professors whose grants begin with the second semester are also invited to attend the Berlin Seminar and get to know their fellow Fulbrighters. You may arrive at your host institution before the Berlin Seminar and participate under the same conditions pertaining to other grantees, if you can work it into your schedule.
